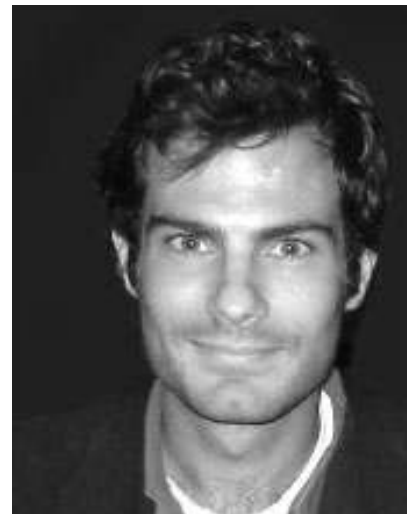

Roger Sedarat is a poet and translator. His first collection of poetry, *Dear Regime: Letters to the Islamic Republic* (Ohio UP), won the 2007 Hollis Summers Prize. He also has recently published a chapbook (*From Tehran to Texas*). In addition to publishing articles on American poetry, Middle Eastern-American literature, and writing pedagogy, he has placed poems and translations in such journals as *The New England Review*, *Atlanta Review*, and *Iranian.com*. A recipient of scholarships to the Bread Loaf Writers' Conference and a St. Botolph Society Grant, he is Assistant Professor in the MFA program in Creative Writing and Literary Translation at Queens College, City University of New York.
